## Jesus Heals The Leper - Lesson Questions

### BIBLE STORY QUESTIONS

- Easy  This week's Bible story was about a man who had leprosy. The Bible does not tell us his name or whether or not he had a family, but we pretended that he had a family so that we can understand what it was like to be a leper. What did we name the Leper's son? *Josh*
- Easy  (True or False) In Jesus' day when someone had the disease of leprosy they had to leave their family and friends. *True.*
- Easy  Because the man in this week's story had leprosy what may he have looked like? *His skin could have been white. He could have lost fingers and toes.*
- Easy  In Jesus' day if you get leprosy you are considered what? *Unclean*
- Hard  How is having leprosy like having sin in our lives? *It can work slowly to destroy us. Sin makes us "unclean" and separates us from others, even loved ones.*
- Hard  Why might this man with leprosy be afraid to go in among a crowd to see Jesus? *Some people may throw stones at him to make him go away.*
- Hard  When Josh's dad approached Jesus he fell on his face and implored Him, saying, "Lord, if You are willing, You can make me clean." How did this show faith in Jesus? *He believed Jesus could heal him.*
- Easy  No one would dare to touch an unclean leper? Did Jesus touch the leper? *Yes, He showed His love and compassion by being the first person to touch Josh's dad in a very long time.*
- Easy  Was the leper healed? *Yes*
- Hard  Lastly Jesus told Josh's dad to go show himself to the priest and make an offering for his cleansing. Who wrote the law concerning this good deed to be done after cleansing? *Moses*
