Jesus And The Storm - Lesson Questions

BIBLE STORY QUESTIONS

- Hard In this week's Bible story Jesus is confronted by a man that wants to join Him. What does the man do for a living? *He is a scribe.*
- Hard After the scribe requests to join Jesus, Jesus tells him: "The foxes have holes and the birds of the air have nests, but the Son of Man has nowhere to _____ " what? *Lay His head.*
- Easy (True or false) You can go to Israel today and see Jesus' home? *False*
- Easy Jesus told a parable in this weeks devotional about a sower. What happened to the seed that fell on the road? *The birds came and ate it up.*
- Easy Jesus later explained the parable. Jesus said: The sower sows the Word. These are the ones who are beside the road where the Word is sown; and when they hear, immediately _____ (who) comes and takes away the Word which has been sown in them? *Satan*
- Hard According to the parable: "Other seed fell on the rocky ground where it did not have much soil; and immediately it sprang up because it had no depth of soil. " What happened next? *"And after the sun had risen, it was scorched; and because it had no root, it withered away..."*
- Hard Jesus later explained the parable. Jesus said: "the ones on whom seed was sown on the rocky places, who, when they hear the Word, immediately receive it with joy; and they have no firm root in themselves, but are only temporary; then, when affliction or persecution arises because of the Word, immediately they fall away". This week's devotional mentioned a scribe. The Bible does not mention his name, but we pretended his name was Shemer and that he wanted to follow Jesus. How was this Shemer like seed that fell on rocky ground? *He wanted to follow Jesus but when he was afflicted by the storm he went away.*
- Hard Jesus said: "These things I have spoken to you, so that in Me you may have peace. In the world you have _____ (what)? *Tribulation (distress or suffering resulting from opposition or persecution)*
- Hard Jesus went on to say: "take courage; I have _____ (what?) the world." *overcome*
