BIBLE STORY QUESTIONS

- Easy There was a special celebration taking place in this week's story. Do you remember what it was?
It was the Passover
- Hard All good Jews celebrate the Passover to remember what? "*You shall remember that you were a slave in the land of Egypt, and the Lord your God brought you out of there by a mighty hand and by an outstretched arm;*" *Deuteronomy 5:15*
- Hard God chose one Jewish man and his brother to confront Pharaoh and insist that he free the Hebrew slaves. What was the name of the man and his brother? *Moses and Aaron*
- Hard God caused many plagues to strike Egypt and thereby encourage Pharaoh to let God's people go. Pharaoh again and again refused to let them go because his heart was _____ what? *hardened*
- Easy Finally there was the last plague where God allowed the angel of death to visit Egypt. What did the Jews name this event? *The Passover*
- Hard The angel of death would take the life of the first born in every house except the houses that did what? "*... and when He sees the blood on the lintel and on the two doorposts, the LORD will pass over the door and will not allow the destroyer to come in to your houses to smite you.*" *Exodus 12:23*
- Easy Blood had to be on the doorpost. Where did the blood need to come from? *The blood must come from the best spotless lamb of the flock.*
- Easy What was the name of the last meal that Jesus had with His disciples? *The Passover meal*
- Easy John the Baptist said: "Behold, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!" Who was John talking about? *Jesus*
- Easy During the Passover meal Jesus took the cup of wine and said to His disciples: "Drink from it, all of you; for this is My blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for forgiveness of sins." *Matthew 26:27*. How are we forgiven of our sins? *By the shed blood of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ the Lamb of God.*
