BIBLE STORY QUESTIONS

- Hard What were the names of the two men that joined Paul on this missionary journey?

- Easy Sergius Paulus, a man of intelligence, sought to hear the word of God from Paul and Barnabus. When Paul tried to speak the "Good News" who tried to stop him?
A false prophet called Bar-Jesus
