Paul's In Ephesus - Lesson Questions

BIBLE STORY QUESTIONS

- Hard Where does Paul begin this second missionary trip that takes him to Ephesus? *Antioch*
- Hard Paul found people that loved God in Ephesus and were baptized. They were not baptized in faith in Jesus but instead how were they baptised? *John the Baptist baptism for the repentance or turning away from sin.*
- Easy Because of this they had never experienced the presence of Who in their lives? *The Holy Spirit*
- Hard Paul baptized them in the name of the Lord Jesus, he then layed hands on them and they received the Holy Spirit and then what happened? *They began speaking with tongues and prophesying.*
- Hard In Ephesus, where is one of the first Jewish meeting places Paul went to so that he might speak the "good news" about Jesus? *The Synagogue*
- Easy Paul ended up spending much of his time teaching both Jews and Greeks in the library of Tyrannus. How many years did he teach there? *Two years*
- Easy God's power flowed through Paul and many wonderful things happened. What happened? *God was performing extraordinary miracles by the hands of Paul, so that handkerchiefs or aprons were even carried from his body to the sick, and the diseases left them and the evil spirits went out.*
- Hard There were some people very impressed with Paul's power. Who were they? *Jewish exorcists, Seven sons of one Sceva, a Jewish chief priest*
- Hard They decided to try to heal people in the name of Jesus just like Paul but how was it different than Paul? *They did not have faith in Jesus and the indwelling of the Holy Spirit as Paul did.*
- Easy The evil spirits knew and recognized the power that Paul had through the name of the Lord Jesus but they knew that the seven sons of Sceva were powerless. So what did the evil spirits do? *They subdued all of them and overpowered them. They BEAT them up!*
- Easy Paul's ministry had such a wonderful impact on the people of Ephesus that the people cleaned up there homes of what? *Bad books on dark magic.*
