Paul In The Storm - Lesson Questions

BIBLE STORY QUESTIONS

- Easy Paul has a unique advantage over many people that lived at his time. He was a Jew but he was also a citizen of what country? *Rome*
- Easy Because Paul was a Roman citizen he could request that his trial be presented to the highest ruler of the time. What was this ruler's name? *Caesar*
- Hard All this was God's plan. Paul would travel to Rome with what close friend? *Luke*
- Hard They began their journey from Caesarea and made their first stop in a port called Fair Haven on what island? *Crete*
- Easy Before they set sail for Rome from Fair Haven the winter was coming and Paul told the captain that he perceived that the trip would be very dangerous. Did the captain listen to Paul and stop the trip? *No, he set sail instead.*
- Easy Sure enough not long after they set sail they were confronted with a storm. What did they do after the first day in the bad storm? *They threw the cargo overboard to lighten the ship.*

- Hard After many days of the storm and with no food the men were very depressed. How did Paul encourage them? *Paul told them that an angel assured him that he would make it to Rome and all the passengers on ship would not drown.*
