BIBLE STORY QUESTIONS

- Easy After Adam and Eve men became more and more wicked. How did God feel about the situation? *He was sorry that he made man and He was grieved in His heart.*
- Hard At this time Noah found favor in the eyes of the LORD, Noah was a righteous man, blameless in his time. He also did what with God? *The Bible says He walked with God.*
- Hard God told Noah to make an ark out of what kind of wood? *Gopher Wood*
- Easy How many windows and doors did the ark have? *One door and one window.*
- Hard The inside and outside of the ark was to be covered with what? *Pitch (Tar)*
- Hard The Bible says that without faith it is impossible to please God (Hebrews 11:6). How did Noah show faith in God? *Noah was warned of coming events that he did not see and he prepared an ark to save his family. Noah acted according to God's Word.*
- Easy Besides food what did God ask Noah to bring into the ark with his family? *Two of every kind of animal.*
- Easy The ark is done. Noah and his family are safe inside. Who gets to close the door of the ark? *God*
- Hard How old was Noah when he finished building the ark? *600 years old.*
- Hard How long did the flood come upon the earth? *40 days*
- Hard Jesus said that the last days when the Lord returns will be just like what time? *The days before the flood.*
- Hard After the flood, Noah and his family came out of the ark. What is the first thing that Noah built? *He built an altar and gave a thank you sacrifice to God.*
- Easy Then God made a covenant (promise) with the earth and made a rainbow as a sign. What was the covenant that God made? *He would never again judge the earth with a flood.*
- Hard The Lord Jesus Christ made a promise with us at the Last Supper. "This cup which is poured out for you is the new covenant in My blood." (Luke 22:20) The next day he died on the cross for our sins. How do we benefit from this covenant or promise? *If we believe in Him as our Lord and Savior then we will have eternal life with Him. (John 3:16)*
