Moses, The Deliverer - Lesson Questions

BIBLE STORY QUESTIONS

- Hard The next portion of Moses' life was spent taking care of sheep in the wilderness. How many years did he take care of the sheep? *40 years*
- Easy Moses is 80 years old and God appears to him. How does God appear to Moses? *A flaming bush that did not burn up.*
- Easy What has God asked Moses to do? *Go to Pharaoh and bring Sons of Israel out of Egypt.*
- Easy (Multiple choice) The Bible says that Moses was the... A. strongest man on earth. B. loneliest man on earth or C. humblest man on earth? *C. The humblest man on earth, Is correct.*
- Hard Moses and his brother confronted Pharaoh. Through them God preformed many signs and wonders hoping that Pharaoh would let the Children of Israel go. Pharaoh would not let them go. What was in Pharaoh that prevented him from doing God's will? *Pharaoh had a hard heart.*
- Hard What is a hard or hardened heart? *A heart that does not seek God's will to be done but instead desires only for themselves. A heard heart will not let God in.*
- Easy What was the last sign, wonder and judgment that came upon Egypt? *All the first born in a family (man and beast) would be struck dead.*
- Hard The only hope one would have is if the angel of death would pass over ones' home. God instructed families that if they put something on their door post that the judgment would pass over them. What did they need to put on their door post? *The blood of a lamb.*
- Easy God also instructed the Children of Israel to be ready for something else the next morning. What was it? *They needed to be ready to leave Egypt.*
- Easy That morning the Children of Israel left Egypt. What did the Egyptians send them off with? *Their gold, silver and clothing.*
- Hard This marked the end of how many years of slavery in Egypt? *400 years*
