BIBLE STORY QUESTIONS

- Hard Through what famous Jewish commander did God work through to bring great military victories for the Hebrews in Israel? *Joshua*
- Easy After Joshua died did the Hebrews remain faithful to God and worship Him only? *No*
- Easy Because the Hebrews turned their backs on God. God allowed punishment for their sins. What happened to the Hebrews in the promised land? *God allowed the cruel Canaanites to over run the land and control the Hebrews.*
- Hard How many years did the cruel Canaanites mistreat the Hebrews? *20 years*
- Hard They controlled the Hebrews with chariots of war. Do you remember how many chariots they had? *Over 900*
- Hard During this time God raised prophets to tell the Hebrews His will and let them know what He was planning. What was the name of the prophetess in this week's story? *Deborah*
- Hard God heard the prayerful cries of His people and He told Deborah to go call a man to lead His people into war against the Canaanites. What was the name of the man? *Barak*
- Easy Barak said he would gather men and go fight against the Canaanites on one condition. What was the condition? *That Deborah go along.*
- Easy Deborah agreed to go along, but because Barak did not have enough faith to go without Deborah coming along, what would happen? *The honor of the win would go to a woman.*
- Hard God brought victory to the Hebrews who did not have fancy weapons. How did God bring victory to the Hebrews? *There was a mighty torrent of rain and the Lord confused Sisera and his chariots as the water in the river Kishon rose to a mighty torrent and swept many of the army away.*
- Easy Sisera the Canaanite commander escaped by foot. He sought refuge in a woman's tent. What happened then? *When he fell asleep the woman killed him with a tent peg. She was given the honor of defeating the cruel enemy leader.*
