BIBLE STORY QUESTIONS

- Hard God sent prophets to the Jews of Israel and Judah to warn them if they continued to sin by worshipping idols and disobeying Him that He would allow neighboring nations to do what? *Punish and conquer them*
- Hard What was the name of one of the last famous Jewish prophets that told the Jews to repent and stop worshipping idols? *Jeremiah*
- Hard The Jews that lived in the south were called the nation of Judah in the Bible story this week. They were conquered and taken away by what nation? *The Babylonians*
- Easy God did not forget His chosen people, the Jews. Even though they sinned He loved them very much. This week's story was about a young Jew that God raised up in Babylon. What was his Jewish name? *Daniel*
- Easy King Nebuchadnezzar of Babylon had a problem and Daniel was brought in to help him. How did Daniel help him? *King Nebuchadnezzar had a dream that troubled him and Daniel explained or interpreted it for him.*
